# Access to Justice: JCI Ibadan Raising the Bar for Fairness and Freedom

Justice should never be a privilege; it is a fundamental right. Yet, across Nigeria, countless individuals remain behind bars not because they have been convicted but because they cannot afford legal representation. For many, the walls of custodial centers are not just physical barriers but symbols of a system that has failed them.

JCI Ibadan, committed to Raising the Bar in service and impact, has taken a bold step to change this narrative. In partnership with the Nigerian Correctional Service (NCS) Oyo State Command, we launched the Access to Justice (A2J) Project 2025 on March 3rd and 4th 2025 with a clear mission to provide legal aid for indigent inmates and help decongest custodial centers.





During our engagement with the Agodi Custodial Centre, the NCS pledged full cooperation, promising to support our efforts in securing justice for those who have been forgotten by the system. We conducted interviews with 24 inmates, 19 men and 5 women, each with a story of hardship, helplessness, and a desperate plea for justice. Their voices echoed a painful reality: without intervention, many would remain detained indefinitely, trapped by circumstances beyond their control.

This initiative is not just about legal aid. It is about restoring hope, upholding human dignity, and ensuring that justice serves all, not just the privileged. By Raising the Bar, JCI Ibadan is reinforcing its commitment to Goal 16 of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, ensuring fairness, equality, and access to justice for the underserved.

We are not just advocating for change. We are making it happen. Justice delayed is justice denied, and we refuse to stand by in silence.







### Women in Jaycee: Spotlight on JCIN Amb. Olaide Bushra Adewuyi



At JCI Ibadan, we celebrate women who are raising the bar, breaking barriers, and making an impact wherever they go. One such inspiring woman is JCIN Ambassador Olaide Bushra Adewuyi, a proud Ibadan-born storyteller now living in Brandon, Manitoba, Canada.

Though miles away from home, Bushra remains deeply connected to her Yoruba heritage, using digital storytelling to bridge the gap between the past and the present, home and the diaspora. Her YouTube channel serves as a vibrant platform where she reviews Yoruba movies, highlights indigenous food, celebrates language and values, and shares relatable experiences of raising children abroad while staying rooted in cultural identity.

Her journey as a content creator took on deeper meaning after relocating abroad, facing the challenges of settling into a new country, and taking a four-year pause to focus on family. When she returned, it was with renewed passion and a sense of purpose—to ensure that Yoruba culture thrives in new generations, no matter where they are in the world.

What started as a personal passion project has now evolved into a growing global community. Through her storytelling, Bushra has connected with like-minded individuals across Canada and beyond, sparking conversations about culture, identity, and belonging. Her work has led her to speak at events and platforms, inspiring others to embrace their heritage and share their own stories.

Bushra attributes much of her confidence, leadership, and public speaking skills to her experiences in JCI Ibadan. The training, opportunities, and encouragement she received within the organization gave her the boldness to step into this new season of impact.

Her Message to Women:

"Impact often begins small—with a story, a video, or a conversation. The work we do in our corner of the world can create ripple effects in ways we never imagined."

Beyond academics, she is a woman of many talents. Her passion for cultural heritage led her to establish a cooking business celebrating her Yoruba and Igbo roots—a venture that has taught her discipline, creativity, and the art of balancing multiple responsibilities.

Ogechi's journey with JCI Ibadan has been nothing short of transformative. Since joining in 2021, she has led impactful projects, including serving as Chairman of the Mental Health Awareness Initiative, Chairman of the Officer Training School, and Team Lead for the Muyiwa Bamgbose Academy.



In 2024, she served as Treasurer, and now, in 2025, she continues her service as the Director of International Affairs, strengthening JCI Ibadan's global partnerships and presence.




