## JCI Ibadan AGM 2025: Growth, Governance & New Beginnings

The 2025 Annual General Meeting of JCI Ibadan was a landmark gathering that blended tradition, accountability, and renewal.

The highlight began with the induction of four new members—Feyisara Ajagbe, Fatimoh Ebunlomo, Paschal Zaki Anyor, and Mariam Okunola—after meeting financial and procedural requirements. 2019 Past President JCIN Amb. Oluwafemi Marquis generously sponsored



Mariam's membership fee, while JCIN Amb. Babatunde Ojobaro (GLC) pledged her convention delegate fee.

The GLC also presented the Constitution Review Report, with 15 amendments and 2 new laws, all adopted after due process with input from past presidents and financial members. Directors, national officers, and Madam President, JCIN Amb. Olajumoke Adelabu, presented their reports, with glowing commendations for her outstanding leadership and prudent

financial management.

The IJEC Report, delivered by JCI Sen. Kayode Adedayo, outlined candidates' qualifications, manifesto guidelines, and election procedures. Following this, elections were conducted with 45 eligible voters. Results declared:




